Values

1. Actively pursues developing his/her relationship with God (the Great Commandment)
 - Deepen his/her love for God, His Word, and people, and express this love through devotions, corporate prayer life, Bible study, fellowship, and witness.
 - Develop a personal vision for the world, and as part of a team develop a strategy for reaching the world for Christ.

2. Actively pursues developing himself/herself for effective ministry (the Great Commission)
 - Has a sense of responsibility for his/her ministry
 - Actively promotes team/ministry activities
 - Has a sense of belonging and mutual accountability with his/her teammates
